

CAMP MANNA SUMMER DAY CAMP

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can my child bring medicine to camp?? Yes, but you MUST fill out a [medication release form](#) and the medicine MUST be left with our counselors to be locked up in our medical supply cabinet. NO ONE is allowed to have medicine, drugs or any form of substance in their possession on our facility.

Can my child buy a lunch on a fieldtrip?? No. Unfortunately our time is very limited when we are on a fieldtrip. Lunches must be brought from home. We WILL NOT allow our staff or campers to purchase food from the fieldtrip location **WHY?** Because we have made prior arrangements to have a shelter or eating location available to us on our fieldtrip. Due to time limits and the need for our group to stay together, we cannot allow anyone to purchase food. If your child forgets their lunch that day, we will provide them with an extra bagged lunch. Please understand, this is not to punish anyone, but rather to optimize our fieldtrip time.

Can my child come for just one day? YES!! Our daily fee is \$25 unless you come on a fieldtrip day which \$30. We want everyone to enjoy their time at Camp Manna. If you are unsure if your child will enjoy this type setting, please join us for a day and try it out. Call our office with other questions or concerns.

I only work two or three days a week, can I send my child on just those days? Yes, the daily fee is \$25/day. You can pick and choose which days. We do require you let us know one week in advance which days they will be attending. This helps us in planning for the next week's events!

My Child has a medical condition that requires special attention and/or a Nurse. Do you provide that service? No. Unfortunately we are not equipped with a Registered Nurse on staff. Our staff are CPR and first aid certified, but we are not equipped to handle major medical conditions. If you have a child that has a medical condition that does not need a RN present, please call our office to verify it is something that can be monitored by our staff. We want your child to be safe. This is an outdoor facility. If you have further questions, please call our office.

Will my child be swimming in the Lake? Yes!! We have certain days and times that are allotted for "Swim Time". We have a designated swimming area divided into shallow end (2-4 feet deep) and deep end (10 feet deep). Our deep end is where the blob, water trampoline and Saturn ball are located. NO ONE is allowed in the water without a life vest!!! NO ONE is allowed to canoe, paddle boat, swim or be on the dock without a life vest!!

Do you have a certified Lifeguard? YES. Our lifeguard will be present for all swim times.

Do you have financial assistance available? We have a scholarship program that awards weeks of camp to students in need of financial assistance. A financial request form must be filled out. Our number of scholarships are based on the amount donated in that current year towards our scholarship program. Please note, we wish we could help every family with discounts and scholarships, however, our funds are very limited. You are not guaranteed to get a scholarship if you submit a request, but we will award as many as we can!!

I have a child in 1st grade and one in 5th grade, will they be separated through the day? Yes and No. Games, bible lessons and challenges will be grouped by ages. Morning Kickoff, snack, free time, lunch, closing, etc. will be as a collective group. There will be plenty of times your child will see their siblings, cousin, etc. however, it is important to divide by ages during certain times for both safety and educational reasons.
