SUMMER DAY CAMP 2022- General Information
JUNE 13th - August 5th

Camp Manna Summer Day Camp is geared for students in grades K through rising 8th. Our weekly themes will be based on Biblical principles and will be incorporated into our crafts and field trips.

REGISTRATION FEE:		\$25 Registration Fee (Until May 1 st , 2022) \$35 LATE Registration Fee
COST:	Option 1 - 5 day a week -	\$150 per week/ 1 student \$250 per week / 2 siblings \$330 per week / 3 siblings <i>**sibling discounts only apply when siblings are attending the same week</i>
	Option 2 - 3 day a week -	\$100 per week/ 1 student \$200 per week/ 2 students \$280 per week/3 students <i>** only a select amount of slots for this option per age group, no sibling discounts apply</i>
	Option 3 - PER DAY	\$40 per day (no discounts given and special activity fees are still extra) <i>** only a select amount of slots for this option per age group</i>
TRANSPORTATION COST:		Riding a bus cost \$10 extra per week per child. ***UPDATE, ADVANCE BUS ROUTE IS AN EXTRA \$15. PRICES WERE RAISED TO HELP OFFSET THE RISING COST OF DIESEL, WE APOLOGIZE FOR THIS UPCHARGE. If you arrive and pick up from Camp Manna there is no additional cost.
Activity FEES:		There are several weeks that have an additional "activity fee" attached, please see website for full details. Most activity fees only apply to older grades (4 th and up), however there are a couple weeks that have an activity fee for all grades. Fees range from \$10-15 per child.

ARRIVAL/PICK UP:

ALL ARRIVAL AND PICKUP will take place at the arbor area! PLEASE check in with our staff when picking up students. If you are arriving earlier than normal pick up, please see a staff member immediately upon arriving to camp. They will get your camper for you!

Arrival at camp: 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 am (Morning Kick-off is around 8:30am)

Pick up at Camp: 4:15 pm - 5:30 pm (Afternoon activities end at 4:15pm)

Mocksville Pick up/ Drop off at Davie County Public Library. (7:45 - 8:00 am & 5:15-5:30pm).

\$10/week fee for this service

Advance Pick up/Drop off at Bermuda Quay Shopping Center. (7:45-8:00am & 5:15-5:30pm). \$10/week fee for this service.

**** Payment!** If you use our transportation service, please include your bus fee in your regular weekly fee (only write one check). **Place in envelope with your child's name on envelope!!** Our drivers will leave promptly at the scheduled times. This ensures campers will arrive in time for morning kickoff. Please direct all transportation changes to Jessica at 336-477-4122 (texting is the quickest, but feel free to call too!)

***** Credit Card Payment.** If you would like to make a card payment, please pay online when you receive your invoice via email

*** Please notify us if you are scheduled to ride the bus and cannot make it. This helps us in wait time!*

*** Some of our bus drivers are volunteers and may or may not know the answers to your questions. Please contact Jessica for specific questions. Thank you!*

Camp Manna reserves the right to charge a \$25.00 late pick up fee per incident for any student who is consistently picked up late.

PAYMENT INFORMATION: Should be made by Friday of the week before your child attends. (or the first day of the week your child attends if paying by check or cash). *Forms of payment include Cash, check, or visa/mastercard. Please make checks payable to Camp Manna Ministries or Camp Manna. Invoices will be sent via email where you can pay directly online!*

THINGS TO BRING: Each day the students will need to be dressed for outdoor activities.

Please Bring the Following Items Each Day!!!

- * Backpack to keep personal items in
- * Lunchbox/Small Cooler/Etc (if you pack lunch, please be sure to include ice pack)
- * Tennis Shoes (If student wears sandals/flip flops, please make sure to pack a pair of tennis shoes for activity time.)
- * Water Bottle (Extremely Important). **BRING EVERYDAY!!**
- * Swimsuit, Beach Towel, and sandals/flip flops for swim days
- * SUNSCREEN!! (spray kind) AND BUG SPRAY!

LUNCH: Lunch will be provided at Camp Manna through the Summer Federal Program (Davie County Schools). It is free to all students. Lunches will be brought to our campus. Campers are welcome to pack their own lunch! **ALL LUNCH WILL BE AT CAMP MANNA** in our new bldg.

SNACKS: A morning and/or afternoon snack will be provided each day. Water is always available!

DRESS CODE: All swimsuits should be one-piece and modest (tankini's are okay as long as they cover the mid-section). All shorts should be mid-thigh length (no short-shorts) No T-shirts with improper advertising or logos. Camp Manna reserves the right to ask any individual to change his/her outfit, if it is considered immodest or inappropriate. *Please call our office if you have any questions or concerns about this. This policy is not in place to punish anyone, however, it is our goal to eliminate distractions and keep our focus on Christ.*

Canteen: Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons we will open Canteen which has snack items, ice cream, sports drinks, etc. (no sodas). All items cost between \$0.25 - \$2.00. If campers wish to purchase items, they can bring money each day or they can put money on their canteen account. **** Separate check or cash must be provided to put in canteen acct. We cannot accept canteen monies along with regular payment.****

SICKNESS & ILLNESS: Do NOT send campers to camp with sicknesses or illnesses. Temps will be checked daily to ensure campers are not arriving at our facility sick. If students have vomited or had diarrhea the night before DO NOT send them to camp. Do NOT send to camp if they have a runny nose, sore throat or any other symptom of illness. Parents will be called to pick up student if student does not feel well through the day.

COVID - We will continue to encourage social distancing and maintain our cleaning procedures to ensure we provide a safe and clean environment. Camp is completely voluntary and we cannot eliminate the risk of Covid or any other viral or contagious disease or infection. Therefore we ask parents to use your caution and help us by not sending your camper to camp if they are not feeling well.

STAFF: We have both staff members and volunteers who work with Camp Manna. We are committed to providing a Christian staff that desires to see your child fully enjoy the summer in a Christ centered atmosphere. It is our intention that each student be shown the love of Christ through our planned activities and relationships with each other and with our counselors. Our staff/volunteers have went through training and have expressed a desire to work in a Christian atmosphere. They have also had background checks run and positive references given. We do our very best to provide quality staff/volunteers who have a desire to see your child have an uplifting time! Most of our staff are CPR certified and we have a certified lifeguard present during swimming times.
